## **PROHIBITED AMMO**

Military Surplus ammo, Steel Core, Steel Jacketed & Tracers are STRICTLY PROHIBITED in our ranges because they can cause extremely serious damages to the equipment in our facilities & can cause very serious wear & tear on your firearm.

ALL AMMO MUST NOW BE VERIFIED BY ONE OF OUR TEAM MEMBERS BEFORE PROCEEDING TO THE RANGES. ANYONE CAUGHT USING ANY TYPE OF PROHIBITED AMMO WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES IMMEDIATELY & MAY RISK HAVING THEIR MEMBERSHIP REVOKED WITHOUT REIMBURSEMENT.

In the recent past we had to have to backstop repaired during a scheduled maintenance due to some members not respecting the regulations nor understanding how dangerous this can be.

We kindly ask that for Everyone's safety, <u>PLEASE DO NOT USE PROHIBITED AMMUNITION IN THE RANGES!\*</u> Unsure if your ammo is Prohibited? Use a magnet on the projectile, if it sticks, it's PROHIBITED and CAN NOT be used. (\*Tracers will not stick to a magnet.\*) - <u>ONLY</u> shotgun slugs are permitted in the Rifle Bay! – Bird shot and Buck shot are prohibited.

#### **RANGE MAINTENANCE**

We recently had our annual range maintenance, by having the ventilation calibrated, the granular rubber on the backstop cleaned out and some of the metal frames repaired. The floors will be repaired, along with having the floors, baffles and walls painted later this summer. **Please visit our website's calendar for updates and more information.** 

## **LAW 9**

We would like to remind all of the CTM's members with "restricted firearms" of the importance to keeping your membership valid and to visit your Shooting Club at least once a year to discharge a "restricted firearms" in order to avoid retaking and paying for the Law 9 exams (Theory and Practical) as stated 46.29 as per the present Law. Even if your membership is expired by one (1) day you will be obliged to retake and repay for the Law 9.
