STEPS TO FOLLOW TO GET THE POSSESSION & ACQUISITION LICENCE (PAL) & TO BECOME A MEMBER AT THE MONTREAL SHOOTING CLUB

Before becoming a member in a shooting club, you need your PAL.

After receiving your PAL, you will have to take the Law 9 course to become a member in a shooting club located in Quebec (for Restricted firearms). DON'T DO IT BEFORE TO GET YOUR PAL!

To become a member of the Montreal Shooting Club, you will also have to do the Safety Course of the club.

HERE ARE THE DIFFERENT STEPS:

TO OBTAIN YOUR PAL

PLEASE - DO NOT TAKE THE LAW 9 COURSE BEFORE TO GET YOUR PAL!

- Take the Non-Restricted course (or exam only***) <u>CFSC</u> Canadian Firearms Safety Course
- 2. Take the Restricted course CRFSC Canadian Restricted Firearms Safety Course
- Fill out the RCMP form CAFC 921 YOU WILL FIND FORMS ON OUR WEBSITE : SECTION "CLUB DE TIR DE MONTREAL USEFUL DOCUMENTATION "
- 4. Print and join the SQ form *In-Person Filing* SQ-3007A (old CAFC 1125F) to the form CAFC 921, DON'T FILL IT!!! The police officer will do it.
- 5. Put everything they ask of you in a large brown envelop, including your picture and the photocopy of both proofs that you got after the courses, with the original sheet from the RCMP (keep a photocopy for your files)
- Do not close the envelop.
- 7. Bring the envelop to the Post Office and be weighed and stamped. DO NOT CLOSE IT YET!
- 8. Bring the envelop to the Police Station in your neighbourhood and the officer in duty will mail it for you after verification.
- 9. The police officer has to give you the receipt of reception of your application that is in the bottom of the form SQ-3007A. This is your proof of mailing.

USUALLY A MINIMUM OF 45 TO 60 BUSINESS DAYS (3 to 4 MONTHS) ARE REQUIRED BEFORE YOU GET YOUR PAL. IT IS POSSIBLE THAT IT WILL BE LONGER UP TO 1 YEAR!

PLEASE NOTE THAT YOU SHOULD ARLREADY HAVE YOUR PAL TO DO THE BILL 9 COURSE.

TO BECOME A MEMBER AT THE MONTREAL SHOOTING CLUB

- 1. FOR THE SAFETY COURSE OF THE CLUB, you have to show up at CTM on Wednesday night around 5:30PM. No need to register before. (See the calendar on our website prior to come: www.crafm.com)
- 2. Bring your PAL (and your Law 9 card IF YOU ALREADY DID THE LAW 9 COURSE or a valid membership card from another club).

***If you work for a Law Enforcement Agency, please bring your badge with you to get the Associate Membership fees.

- 3. TO DO THE LAW 9 COURSE, YOU HAVE TO REGISTER ON THE FQT'S WEBSITE BEFORE THE COURSE www.fqtir.qc.ca
- 4. Then you will do the Safety course of the club from 6pm to 7pm
- -> FEES: \$ 110.00 + taxes

Then you will do the Law 9 course from 7pm to 10pm.

(Please arrive around 5H30PM anyway.)

- -> FEES: \$ 66.84 THEORETICAL EXAM already paid when registered on the FQT's website.
- -> FEES* FOR THE AMMUNITION AND FIREARM FOR PRACTICAL TEST: \$40.00 (Including taxes) to pay on-site *PRICES SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE.
- i. The same evening, we will do your membership (ONLY IF YOU HAVE YOUR PAL AND IF THE SAFETY COURSE AND THE LAW 9 COURSE ARE DONE) and then you can buy a firearm, if you wish.
- *** NOTE: IF YOU WANT TO DO THE HUNTING COURSE ICAF (OPTIONAL), YOU SHOULD HAVE DONE THE COMPLETE NON-RESTRICTED COURSE. THE EXAM ONLY IS NOT SUFFICIENT.
